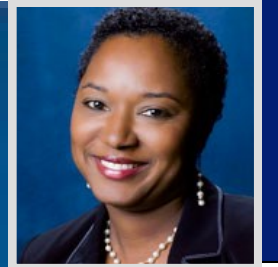

## PURSUIT SAFETY



State Senator Lena C. Taylor (D – Milwaukee) Racine County Sheriff's Office is hosting a StarChase demonstration for law enforcement to come learn about the popular pursuit management tool. In support of public safety and reducing dangerous pursuits, Senator Lena C. Taylor, District 4 and Corey Foster, Wisconsin DOT-Bureau of Transportation Safety will be there to introduce the technology to local law enforcement agencies. On average pursuit related crashes result in 55,000 injuries a year. While high speed chases can be dangerous, they serve an important purpose in apprehending criminals and maintaining public safety. StarChase technology presents a reasonable alternative to high speed pursuits that allows law enforcement agency to apprehend suspects with minimal public safety risk. Local Law enforcement agency and legislators will be able to see a live demonstration of the technology as well as participate in an information session. There is a press conference open to members of the media, where community members who have lost loved ones in pursuits, a representative from StarChase, and representatives from law enforcement agencies will speak pursuit management.

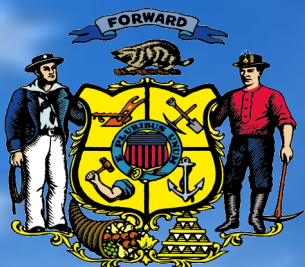
