Madison, WI – Today, Senator Dan Feyen (R-Fond du Lac), released the following statement on Senate Bill 1:

"After the holding a hearing in January to get to the bottom of the issues within the State's Unemployment system, my colleagues and I immediately went to work to address the problem. I am proud of my vote today on Senate Bill 1 and am excited for this to be overwhelmingly passed in the Assembly and sent to the Governor's desk for signature.
