SUBJECT: Full Medicaid Expansion under the ACA: Updated Estimate

At your request, this memorandum provides an updated fiscal estimate of increasing BadgerCare Plus income eligibility standards for nondisabled, non-elderly adults to 133% of the federal poverty level (FPL) under provisions of the federal Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (ACA). This option is commonly referred to as a "full expansion" of Medicaid program eligibility under the ACA.

The following table provides this estimate for the 2015-17 biennium, if this policy is implemented on January 1, 2016. This has been updated from this office's February, 2015, estimate to reflect more recent BadgerCare Plus enrollment data.
