## **Senator Lazich Applauds Voter ID Ruling**

**Madison, Wis.** – Today, the U.S. Supreme Court upheld Wisconsin voter ID law by rejecting the argument that requiring voters to present photo identification at the polls is disenfranchisement. In reaction, Senate President Mary Lazich (R- New Berlin) issued the following remarks:

*“This long awaited ruling is a win for Wisconsin voters. The U.S Supreme Court’s refusal to review the federal appeals court ruling proves Wisconsin’s voter ID law is constitutional. The ruling ensures the voting process is honest and conveys one-person-one-vote. Lack of photo ID was a real problem, a problem voters wanted solved.*”

*“Requiring voters to present identification is a common sense practice that protects the integrity of our electoral process. It is without question worthwhile to be able to ensure that persons voting during elections are legitimate voters.”*
