Assembly Amendment on AB305 will be same as Senate Companion
Sen. Stroebel to continue to work with caucus on final passage

Madison, WI – Senator Duey Stroebel (R-Cedarburg) issued a statement following the release of an Assembly substitute amendment on AB305:

In concert with Representatives Kleefisch and Jacque, I and my staff have been working with key stakeholders to find solutions on some key research issues as they related to the original bill. Ultimately, we have made the policy decision to set a high ethical standard for Wisconsin research. The bill allows for lifesaving research utilizing existing cell lines.

I anticipate the bill to have a Senate public hearing soon. I will continue to work with members of my caucus and leadership team to shepherd this bill to final passage.

In the end, we have a bill that keeps the original intent, protects the dignity of all human life especially the unborn, and ensures lifesaving research continues in Wisconsin.
