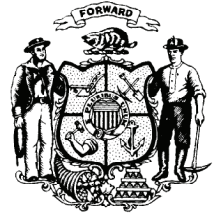

Dear state legislator,

As state legislators representing communities along the Minnesota and Wisconsin border, we have scheduled a meeting regarding tax reciprocity for October 12th at 9:00 a.m. in Woodbury, Minnesota. We are inviting legislators from the border areas of both states and will seek a strategy that will lead to the reinstatement of our long-standing and mutually beneficial income tax reciprocity agreement.

As you know, income tax reciprocity is a critical agreement that benefits tens-of-thousands of our constituents from both states. There is considerable concern amongst legislators and we believe a coordinated effort would be helpful in working toward a solution. We plan to have nonpartisan legislative and research staff available to address questions and are opening the meeting to state agencies involved with the decision to end reciprocity.
