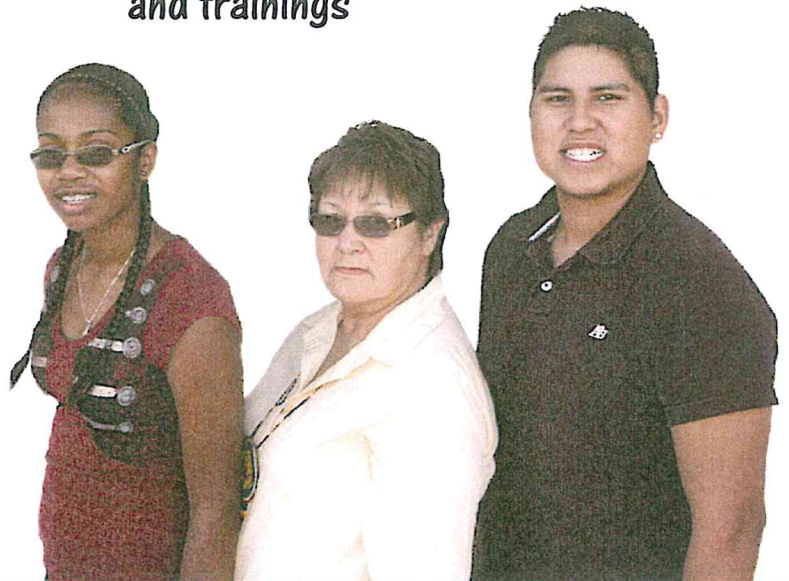
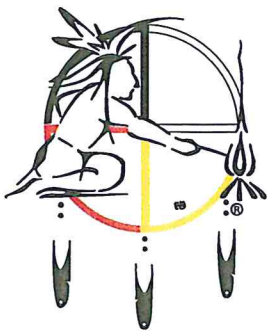

- ✓ 24/7 Hotline (715) 478-7201

- ✓ Medical advocacy and referral
- ✓ Emotional support whether abuse was current or in the past
- ✓ Referrals to the Office of Victim Services & Programs (OVSP) for information and advocacy to victims and survivors of crime.
