## Rep. Born Votes to Protect Women and Children

**Madison, WI**—Representative Mark Born (R-Beaver Dam) voted for several bills that protect women's sports, prevent children from viewing pornographic material, and prevent children from receiving puberty-suppressing drugs and surgeries.

"Women and girls have the same right to privacy as men and boys do. We must ensure that women and girls are able to participate in sports, school, and our communities by providing them a level playing field. Assembly Bills 100 and 102 provide protections for women and girls at all levels of education by requiring separate sports and locker rooms by biological sex."

"Assembly Bill 105 prohibits children from viewing pornographic material and I am proud to cast my vote to keep children from viewing this harmful and addicting content."

"One of the most important bills that I voted for on the Assembly floor today was AB 104, which prohibits health care providers from referring children to receive puberty-suppressing drugs and surgeries. Allowing children to undergo life-altering surgery when they are under the age of 18 simply should not be allowed here in Wisconsin. I stand with children and families who are working to provide the mental health and medical care that these children need, instead of pushing a dangerous political agenda on vulnerable kids."
