## 2023: Year in Review

**Madison** – Representative Ron Tusler (R- Harrison) issued the following statement reflecting on 2023 in the state legislature:

“2023 has been a year of great challenges and successes as we continue to try and meet these challenges with responses that benefit the people of Wisconsin and the 3<sup>rd</sup> Assembly District especially. I want to thank all of the constituents who reached out to my office looking for help and bringing our attention to certain issues. This year saw us pass bills to: keep the Brewers in Wisconsin until at least 2050, bring shared tax revenue from our counties and municipalities back into their own hands, allow for smaller cities like Kimberly to receive DNR grants to help maintain their parks, and a bill to prevent late-night absentee ballot counting in future elections by allowing for processing of absentee ballots to begin on Monday.

This year, many of our best bills were vetoed by the governor. We passed three different tax cuts in the Legislature that were vetoed by the governor in a year of record inflation. The governor also vetoed 51 provisions in the budget, which we passed in the legislature, that would have reduced the tax burden on Wisconsinites and helped push the Woke agenda out of our schools and government. Despite the early setbacks and partisan politics, we were able to work pragmatically to get important bills passed that will help: our local communities, secure our elections, and invest in a prosperous future.

It is an honor to continue to serve as your state representative and I want to wish everyone a Merry Christmas and Happy New Year!”
