Rep. Goeben Champions Women

Madison – State Representative Joy Goeben (R-Hobart) voted in favor of women yesterday. Legislation in the Assembly passed ensuring that the many years of hard fought gains in women's sports remain.

Title IX, a landmark federal law enacted in 1972 became law and over the past four decades has been instrumental in fostering a culture of opportunity and excellence in women's sports. Title IX has transformed the landscape of athletics by ensuring that every young woman has a fair chance to pursue her athletic dreams.

"While some might try to say the opportunity for women to pursue their dreams causes hurt feelings, I say, 'stop projecting.' Women have worked tirelessly for the right to vote, for equal pay, and to participate in sports on a level playing field. The blood, sweat and tears of those who have worked for equality should not be hijacked by biological males," said Rep. Goeben.

AB 377 and AB 378 now head to the state Senate for consideration. Once signed by Gov. Evers, the law will be applied the first semester or session after the effective date.
