



2017 ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION

1 **Relating to:** condemning the violence perpetuated by groups to achieve an end.

2 Whereas, the Wisconsin State Assembly, on August 17th, 2017, unanimously
3 adopted August 2017 Special Session Assembly Resolution 1; and

4 Whereas, the resolution condemned “all those who rely on violence and hatred
5 to advance their cause”; and

6 Whereas, the resolution further added that it is the responsibility of lawmakers
7 “as citizens and public servants dedicated to building a better Wisconsin and a better
8 country, to denounce such acts of violence”; and

9 Whereas, in Berkeley, a “Rally Against Hate” peaceful gathering was attacked
10 by violent supporters of anarchy and members of the antifa movement; and

11 Whereas, this is yet another disturbing, sad event in a disturbing trend of
12 violence perpetuated by both the far-right and the far-left; and

13 Whereas, no matter the political considerations, members of the State
14 Assembly must stand resolute in opposing and denouncing violence; and
