Wisconsin Democrats Introduce Legislation For The People *Hot Topics Include Affordable Housing, Food, Healthcare*

MADISON—Wisconsin Assembly and Senate Democrats introduced the “Lowering Costs, Improving Lives” package of bills today to address food, housing, and healthcare costs for Wisconsinites. Rep. Robyn Vining (D-Wauwatosa) released the following statement:
