Rep. Kalan Haywood Re-elected as Assembly Assistant Democratic Leader

Madison, Wis. – Today, Representative Kalan Haywood (D-Milwaukee) was re-elected to the position of Assistant Democratic Leader by the Assembly Democratic Caucus.
