Rep. Moore Omokunde on Third Term Inauguration: "Good to be Back in the Saddle"

MADISON – This afternoon, State Representative Supreme Moore Omokunde (D-Milwaukee) was inaugurated for his third term in the Wisconsin State Assembly.
