## Wisconsin Counties Association Names Rep. Goyke "Outstanding Legislator"

Recognition follows on collaborative efforts with Wisconsin counties to bring meaningful change to Wisconsin's juvenile corrections system

**MADISON** – Today the Wisconsin Counties Association honored Rep. Evan Goyke (D-Milwaukee) as an "Outstanding Legislator" prior to the first meeting of the Juvenile Corrections Study Committee at the Wisconsin Department of Corrections Headquarters. Rep. Goyke was recognized for his close collaborative efforts with Wisconsin counties as the legislature drafted and passed 2017 Wisconsin Act 185, which brings important reforms to Wisconsin's juvenile corrections system.
