Madison- State Representative Janel Brandtjen (R- Menomonee Falls) issued the following statement regarding the City of Milwaukee cutting 60 police officers while banning plastic straws.

“The City of Milwaukee led by Mayor Barrett continues to put citizens, workers, visitors and police officers in harm’s way. Reducing the police force while banning plastic straws is stunning to say the least.
