LEGISLATIVE UPDATE | SPRING 2024

Education:

- Authored legislation for grants to enable expansion of dental training programs at Tech Colleges – signed into law 1/31/24
- Voted in favor of a driver education grant program
- Introduced legislation to ensure the teaching of cursive writing is taught in elementary schools
- Member of the Speakers Task Force on Truancy; introducing legislation to address truancy in our schools and to establish uniform reporting requirements for districts to report truancy numbers

Environmental:

- Supports renewable energy initiatives
- Voted in favor of farmland preservation agreements and tax credits
- Backs conservation efforts for wildlife habitats and biodiversity
- Supports developments of parks and recreational areas

Economy-Business Support / Local Government:

- Cosponsored legislation to attract and retain businesses in Wisconsin
- Backs initiatives to cut bureaucracy and the over regulation of businesses
- Supports workforce development programs to enhance the skills of the local labor force
- Voted for a \$3 Billion dollar tax cut, which includes tax cuts for retirement income

Public Safety:

- Cosponsored legislation for small law enforcement agencies' training by creating a grant pilot program
- Supports measures to enhance emergency preparedness and response capabilities
- Cosponsored legislation for increased funding for mental health services to reduce the burden on law enforcement
- Supports the Innovation Fund; \$300 million, three-year pilot program for communities to collaborate and reduce the size and cost of government through consolidation
- Voted to help combat human trafficking

Election Integrity:

- Voted in favor of prohibiting state and local governments from using privately sourced moneys or equipment in connection with the conduct of elections "aka Zuckerbucks"
- Voted in favor of a constitutional amendment to require ID's to vote in elections
