## **Rep. Brill Denounces Radical Democrat Abortion Bill**

**Madison, WI** – Today, Democrats in the Legislature began circulating their ‘Abortion Rights Preservation Act.’ Among other things, the legislation repeals the language found in Wisconsin’s 1849 abortion limitation – betraying Leftist judicial arguments against its statutory significance. Senator Kelda Roys (D – Madison), in her characteristic obtuseness, introduced the bill fewer than 24 hours after making impassioned remarks on the Senate floor regarding the Holocaust. In response to the snake-oil legislation which will be falsely hailed as female-empowerment, Representative Lindee Brill (R – Sheboygan Falls) made the following statement:
