Rep. Lindee Brill Rebukes Governor Evers Over Ukraine Statement

Madison – In the aftermath of the Trump-Zelensky Oval Office meeting on February 28, 2025, Governor Tony Evers issued a <u>statement</u> along with several Democratic governors siding with President Zelensky of Ukraine and lambasting President Trump. State Representative Lindee Brill (R – Sheboygan Falls) made the following comments in response:

"Governor Evers has demonstrated once again, what Americans across the country have come to recognize about Democratic politicians: they will take any opportunity to savage Donald Trump, even if they must side with a foreign leader over our own. Any serious observer who watched the entire sit down in the Oval Office on Friday – and not just the deceptively clipped 10-minute version – would be able to identify that Zelensky's aggressive and petulant attitude instigated the heated back-and-forth. President Trump and Vice President Vance, who the unelected Ukrainian leader disrespectfully referred to as 'JD,' were *absolutely justified* in their response to Zelensky's hostile behavior.

It comes as no surprise that the Democrats and the Leftist media apparatus have sought once again to mislead the American people on a matter involving Donald Trump. However, it is unacceptable for Governor Evers to continue seizing upon ever opportunity to attack and savage the man who won a decisive victory in our state mere months ago. The ridiculous statement itself is easily dismissed from the first sentence when members of Bill Clinton's party engage in sanctimony over their perceived misuse of America's 'sacred Oval Office.'
