## REP. ROB KREIBICH COLUMN: REPRESENTATIVE ROB KREIBICH AND REPUBLICANS ANNOUNCE CRACKDOWN ON ILLEGAL CRIMINALS

MADISON.... Wisconsin is facing a significant public safety crisis.
