Rep. Moses Votes to Strengthen Workforce Housing

Madison – Rep. Clint Moses (R-Menomonie) voted in favor of a package of bills that aims to strengthen workforce housing development across the state.

Wisconsin is currently grappling with a severe housing shortage, facing a historic low in statewide housing inventory and seeing a steady rise in median home prices. Over the past decade, Wisconsin has produced 10,000 fewer single-family homes annually in comparison to the previous decade. Construction costs for a single-family home have surged by more than 35% since 2020, while government regulations continue to add excessive costs and delays to the housing development process.

The package encompasses a series of legislation that would establish next-generation workforce housing, revitalize main street housing, modernize aging housing, and repurpose vacant commercial developments for residential use. It also includes a provision to increase the low-income housing tax credit from \$42 million to \$100 million.

“These bills are a step in the right direction to solve Wisconsin’s housing crisis,” said Rep. Moses. “This package of bills will help make it easier for Wisconsinites to achieve their dreams of owning a home.”

The legislative package now heads to the State Senate for consideration before going to the governor for his approval.
