Governor Evers Vetoes Tax Relief, Again

Madison, WI – Governor Evers vetoed three bills aimed at providing tax relief to Wisconsin citizens. One bill was authored by Representative Ellen Schutt (R- Clinton).

Following the vetoes, Representative Schutt made the following statement:

"I'm incredibly disappointed Governor Evers vetoed much needed tax relief targeted at helping our middle class, retirees, and married couples. Wisconsinites NEED relief from inflation and yet they will be stuck with higher taxes and more government spending.

"There is no reason these bills had to become political. We can afford a tax cut. If enacted, Wisconsin would still have over a \$1 billion surplus to start the next biennium.

"I'm especially disappointed to see my bill that would have provided relief for married couples, updating the current tax credit to adjust for inflation, was vetoed. I will continue to fight for what is best for my constituents. I believe taxpayers know how to spend their hard-earned dollars better than the government."
