Revenue Estimates Show Growth, Require Sound Budgeting

Collections remain strong, cost-to-continue remains high

MADISON, WI – Today, the Legislative Fiscal Bureau (LFB) released new revenue estimates. The numbers reflect growth despite economic uncertainty. In response to the updated estimates, Joint Committee on Finance (JFC) Co-Chairs Senator Howard Marklein (R-Spring Green) and Representative Mark Born (R-Beaver Dam) made the following statement:

"These estimates reflect the success of Republican budgets for more than a decade. Our commitment to responsible budgeting and sound financial practices has once again put the State of Wisconsin in a strong fiscal position.

"While we are encouraged by these new estimates, we remain cautious as we head into the next biennial budget. Our cost-to-continue remains substantial and even with these expected revenue increases, we must remain vigilant when crafting a budget for Wisconsin.

"Our substantial surplus remains here in the state coffers instead of the pockets of hard-working Wisconsinites for one simple reason; Governor Evers. His refusal to support meaningful tax relief has kept that money locked up here in Madison.
