Rep. Born Responds to Gov. Evers' State of the State Address

Madison, WI—Today, Representative Mark Born (R-Beaver Dam) released the following statement in response to Governor Evers' State of the State Address:

"Tonight Governor Tony Evers provided the legislature with his vision for Wisconsin. He touted Republican-authored tax cuts, increasing employment, and responsible budgeting, but his plan would take us in the opposite direction.

"Governor Evers is only telling you part of the story; while he is taking credit for the efforts of legislative Republicans, he failed to mention the dozens of items that he vetoed, that would have taken Wisconsin in the right direction.

"Assembly Republicans have consistently fought to lower the tax burden in Wisconsin, sending a comprehensive tax cut of almost \$3 billion to Governor Evers multiple times. The Governor vetoed those tax cuts, reducing the savings for families from over \$1,000 per family under our plan to less than \$100 after his veto.

"Assembly Republicans will spend this session fighting for priorities that are important to hardworking Wisconsinites; addressing the cost of living, focusing on school accountability, keeping our communities safe, and supporting an economy that works. Governor Evers would like to spend this session focusing on tax and spend policies, the wishes of national special interests, and fighting the federal government.

"I look forward to working with my legislative colleagues to cut taxes, stop DPI from shortchanging our students, support our law enforcement professionals, and build an economy that makes Wisconsin an attractive place to live, work, and raise a family.
