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## REOPEN WISCONSIN GENERAL GUIDELINES

The following are some of the general steps that should be considered in creating a plan to reopen our state for business:

1. Identify what the roadblocks are with PPE & testing to get them solved NOW. Use the Defense Production Act to its fullest extent to get these troubles remedied while still making a clearly delineated plan to reopen business beginning May 1st.
2. Convene non-government experts [doctors, nurses, human resource directors, & chamber of commerce directors] to create clear, measurable guidelines for what safe operation of business looks like. For example, taking temperature of employees as they enter the workplace, masks, gloves, and physical distancing might be measures.
3. Create infrastructure guidelines for law enforcement and municipalities so they are clear in the boundaries of this plan going forward.
4. Reassure the public with state PSA's letting Wisconsinites know how our coronavirus cases & death rates compare to our usual death rates & cases in this state.
5. Begin allowing medical facilities to create safe strategies and begin seeing non-COVID-19 patients throughout the state.
6. Create a 3 tiered phase-in of church gatherings with first 10, then 50, then full attendance of worshipers at services.
7. Convene county business organizations to coordinate procedures & a tiered plan for reopening business over the next 3 months (Early starters might be salons, pet grooming, or others that can safely take one customer at a time as well as sports viewed on television only. Next might be those who can have enough square footage to keep customers at a safe distance. Finally, allow restaurants to begin seating customers.)
8. Open green spaces such as parks, boat launches, as well as hunting, fishing, & practice ranges.
9. Plan for televised graduation ceremonies where only students can walk the stage to receive diplomas.
10. Examine the possibility of attendance at weddings and funerals by mid-June. (Coordinate with church reopening.)
11. Allow for possibility of summer school classes of 10 or less beginning in mid-June.
12. Keep summer camps closed for the season to allow regrouping of the rest of society.
