Rep. Mark Born Votes to Protect those with Pre-Existing Conditions

Madison – Rep. Mark Born (R-Beaver Dam) issued the following statement after the passage of Assembly Bill 1 (AB 1) that protects those with pre-existing conditions from losing healthcare coverage:

"I am proud that the first act of the Wisconsin State Assembly was voting to protect residents of the 39th Assembly District with pre-existing conditions from losing access to their health insurance. Everyone knows someone who is affected by a pre-existing condition. With the uncertainty at the federal level of government, it is important for Wisconsin to lead on this issue and make sure these protections are in place.
