Rep. Conley Authors Prescription Drug Pricing Transparency Bill

MADISON - Yesterday, Rep. Sue Conley (D-Janesville) introduced legislation targeting prescription drug pricing transparency. The bill is a part of the Building Economic Security Together (BEST) Agenda, led by Sen. Melissa Agard (D-Madison).

“I am thrilled to release this legislation alongside my colleagues, Sen. Agard and Sen. Erpenbach,” Rep. Conley stated. “This bill requires pharmaceutical companies to report to the state when drug prices increase by more than 25%, ensuring all Wisconsinites can access their medication without fear of financial harm. The bill was originally introduced by my predecessor, former Rep. Debra Kolste, and I am happy to carry it forward.

“I support the entire BEST Agenda, which prioritizes ordinary Wisconsinites at every stage of their life and promotes economic security to help everyone reach their dreams,” Rep. Conley added. The BEST Agenda also includes bills establishing bonds for infants, a state-run retirement marketplace, pension relief for public safety and other frontline workers, housing assistance, and a plan to increase minimum wages.
