## Rep. Conley Supports Child Care Tax Credits

MADISON – Today, the Wisconsin State Assembly met in regular session and took up several tax related bills. Representative Sue Conley (D-Janesville) issued the following statement in response:

"My Democratic colleagues and I have advocated for Child Care Counts and other measures to address the child care crisis in Wisconsin throughout this legislative session. Assembly Bill 1023 allows families with dependents to increase the amount filers can claim on their taxes when caring for a child. I supported AB 1023 on the floor today, because it is a step in the right direction.

"However, it is only that-a step. We must do more to ease child care costs for families, and to support child care facilities staying open. I once again call on my Republican colleagues to support Child Care Counts and build on the progress made today.

"We also voted on an amended version of a redistricting bill. Robin Vos has shown time and again that he cannot be trusted when it comes to legislative redistricting and that he will do whatever it takes to keep his power. We just don't know what his next step will be to prevent fair maps from becoming a reality."
