DAIRY FARM GRANTS AVAILABLE TO AREA FARMERS

MADISON - Area dairy farmers can take advantage of the new Grow Wisconsin Dairy Team grants to expand and modernize their facilities. Awards of \$88,882 to 27 dairy producers have already been awarded, but over \$900,000 in grants are still available.

We value our dairy farmers' contribution to Wisconsin by taking advantage of these grants which will help revitalize this critical element of Wisconsin's economy. Many of the grants will focus on engineering and design projects, or will utilize cutting-edge techniques.

The Department of Agriculture, Trade, and Consumer Protection encourages dairy producers, processors, and local organizations to apply for funds. So far, no farms in the 46th Assembly District have received these grants. I strongly encourage any local dairy farms to take advantage of this opportunity to grow.
