Representative Udell Introduces Pride Month Equality Package Alongside Fellow Dems

MADISON, Wis. — On May 29th, legislative Democrats introduced six bills in their Equality Agenda package. These bills include a constitutional amendment to protect same-sex marriage, eliminating the so-called "gay panic" legal defense, and a resolution to recognize June 2025 as LGBTQ+ Pride Month in commemoration of the Stonewall uprising.

Representative Randy Udell (D-Fitchburg) released the following statement:
