Representative Udell Condemns National Republicans for Withholding Epstein Files

MADISON, Wis – on July 15<sup>th</sup>, House Republicans voted unanimously to block a Democratic maneuver that would force the Trump administration to release the Epstein files.

Representative Randy Udell (D-47<sup>th</sup> District) released the following statement:
