## **Rep. Tranel Thanks Jordan Pergande for Service to the 49<sup>th</sup> Assembly District**

Madison – Today, State Representative Travis Tranel (R-Cuba City) and the Chair of the Assembly Committee on Agriculture congratulates Jordan Pergande on the completion of his tenure as a Legislative Intern at the Wisconsin State Capitol in Madison.

This past fall and spring, Jordan served as a Legislative Intern for Rep. Tranel at his Wisconsin State Assembly office while attending the University of Wisconsin – Madison as a full-time student. Jordan, a Kieler native, has always had a passion for politics and public service. Prior to joining the office, he served as a volunteer firefighter for the Jamestown Fire Department and organized a campaign to run as a candidate for the Southwestern School Board that culminated in a close, razor-thin election.

While studying political science at UW-Madison, Jordan assisted the office with constituent outreach, policy research, press releases, and attended a number of events at the capitol. “I am extremely grateful for the opportunity to intern at Rep. Tranel’s office and give back to the Southwest Wisconsin community I grew up in and continue to enjoy,” said Jordan. “This has been a wonderful experience learning the ins and outs of the state legislative process— not only did I get to see how policy is made firsthand, but I also got the chance to contribute to the process and learn more than I ever expected.”

This unique opportunity allowed him to gain practical, experience working in a legislative office while simultaneously earning college credit. By participating in this program, Jordan was able to apply his academic knowledge to real-world situations, develop professional skills, and build valuable connections, all while fulfilling the requirements for his degree.
