Legislative Democrats Release Bill Package for Voter Confidence, Accessibility, Residency, and Ease

MADISON, Wis. - Today, Legislative Democrats proudly introduce the Voter C.A.R.E. (Confidence, Accessibility, Residency, and Ease) Package, a common sense set of bills designed to ensure our government represents the will of the people. Committed to accessible and straightforward elections, this legislative initiative focuses on reforming unnecessary requirements, improving in-person voting, and supporting local election operations.

At its core, the package expands early in-person voting, providing voters with flexibility and additional time to research candidates. Package underscores the Democrats' commitment to removing unnecessary barriers and making it easier for every eligible Wisconsinite to exercise their fundamental right to vote.
