Rep. Palmeri Defends Voters Rights, Votes for Protecting Wisconsin's Constitution

MADISON, Wis. – Rep. Lori Palmeri (D-Oshkosh) issued a statement following the Wisconsin State Assembly vote on Assembly Joint Resolution 1, a proposal to duplicate the state's existing voter ID law in the state constitution. The proposal, which passed the Legislature 55-45, will be placed on the ballot for voter approval in the upcoming April election.

Rep. Palmeri released the following statement:

"Instead of addressing the issues that matter most to Wisconsin voters—like lowering the cost of groceries, reducing prescription drug prices, and making our schools safer—Republicans' first priority this session was to duplicate existing voter ID law in the state constitution."

"All voters deserve to participate in free and fair elections. Wisconsin law already requires voters to present photographic identification at the polls. Amending our constitution should be reserved for matters of true significance, not partisan gamesmanship."
