Last session day until 2018 does nothing to help Wisconsin families

Republicans continue to pursue failing Trump-Walker Agenda

MADISON – The State Assembly met today for the last time until 2018. Despite this opportunity to address the pressing issues facing Wisconsin, Republicans continued pursuing the failing Trump-Walker agenda, which does nothing to help Wisconsin families. Assembly Democratic Leader Representative Gordon Hintz (D-Oshkosh) released the following statement regarding the floor session.

“This week, it has become clear that people around the country are rejecting a Republican Party in disarray.
