Rep. Hintz: Assembly Passes UW Oshkosh Sesquicentennial Resolution

MADISON – Today, the Wisconsin State Assembly **unanimously** passed Assembly Joint Resolution (AJR) 19, recognizing and celebrating the University of Wisconsin Oshkosh Sesquicentennial. Representative Gordon Hintz (D-Oshkosh) released the following statement regarding the passage of the resolution:

“I am thrilled the Wisconsin State Assembly voted to commemorate the University of Wisconsin Oshkosh sesquicentennial. Since its founding 150 years ago, UW Oshkosh has served as a beacon of learning, leadership, opportunity and community, and has become a truly irreplaceable part of the Oshkosh community and of northeastern Wisconsin. I am proud to represent UW Oshkosh in the Assembly, and excited for what the future has in store for this outstanding institution of higher education.

I also encourage the legislature to enact Governor Evers’ Badger Bounceback budget, which includes investments that will strengthen UW Oshkosh and maintain affordability and accessibility for its students.”
