## Representative Snodgrass Releases Statement on Budget Signing

MADISON - Rep. Snodgrass (D- Appleton) released the following statement on Governor Evers signing the 2021-23 state budget and announcing the investment of \$100 million federal dollars in Wisconsin's public schools:

"I commend Governor Evers on using his partial veto authority to make a bad budget better and address some of the significant areas lacking in the GOP budget that was submitted to him. The Governor's announcement that he would invest \$100 million in federal dollars directly to Wisconsin's classrooms proves he remains the "education Governor" at heart. These funds will provide meaningful assistance which was left out of the GOP budget and make a real difference for Wisconsin's children.

In addition, the Governor was able to deliver on his promise of tax cuts to the middle class. I had faith in the Governor's partial veto authority and sound fiscal management to fix key problems with the budget I voted against.
