Rep. Rob Brooks cosponsors prevailing wage repeal Prevailing wage repeal to save taxpayers hundreds of millions of dollars annually

Madison, WI—Representative Rob Brooks (R-Saukville) cosponsored a bill to eliminate Wisconsin's prevailing wage laws, recognizing that it provides significant budget savings; allowing more money to be invested in education, jobs training, debt and retirement.

"I strongly support Representative Hutton's proposal to repeal Wisconsin's prevailing wage laws," said Representative Rob Brooks. "This legislation is poised to save hard-working Wisconsin taxpayers hundreds of millions of dollars annually; promote broader participation among minority and independent contractors; and save private contractors time and money from filling out bureaucratic surveys," said Rep. Rob Brooks.

This legislation completely repeals Wisconsin's prevailing wage laws—originally enacted in 1931 and 1933—and retains the federal law for projects with federal funding.

"I am honored to attach my name to a piece of legislation that will save taxpayers hundreds of millions of dollars annually and allow us to reinvest in our communities," said Representative Rob Brooks.
