Rep. Rob Brooks Ready to Tackle State Budget

Madison, WI—State Representative Rob Brooks (R-Saukville) issued the following statement after Governor Walker's budget address Tuesday evening.

"Governor Walker's budget proposal provides a solid conservative foundation that I intend to improve upon. As I work with my colleagues on the budget, I aim to put taxpayers first, reform government and invest in education. I am excited to get to work on the new two-year state budget.

"It is now time to find ways to improve the Governor's proposal for the people of Wisconsin's 60th Assembly District, and Wisconsin.
