## Rep. Brooks Selected to Serve on Water Quality Task Force

**Madison, WI**—Today, Representative Rob Brooks (R-Saukville) was selected to serve on the Speaker's Task Force on Water Quality, a bipartisan panel tasked with making recommendations for improving water quality in the Badger State.

"As a former member of the Ozaukee County Board and Southeast Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission, I am familiar with water quality issues and their importance to our local communities. I represent a district that abuts Lake Michigan and contains several large farms and other businesses that are affected by these issues," Representative Brooks said.

The task force has been asked to make recommendations for improving surface and groundwater. Legislators will hold public hearings throughout the state to gather information on the specific concerns raised throughout Wisconsin.

"I look forward to working with my colleagues to identify ways to ensure that every Wisconsinite has access to safe, clean, and healthy drinking water. Additionally, I want to ensure that farmers in my district are not adversely affected by this committee's recommendations," Representative Brooks stated.
