Representative Brooks Named Chairman of the Assembly Committee on Housing and Real Estate for the 2023-2024 Legislative Session

Madison, WI—Today, Representative Rob Brooks (R-Saukville), was appointed chairman of the Assembly Committee on Housing and Real Estate for the 2023-2024 legislative session.

The Assembly Committee on Housing and Real Estate will focus on making housing more affordable and accessible, streamlining burdensome regulations that impede development. It will also prioritize upgrading the state’s existing housing stock.
