Rep. Kerkman Releases Update of Kenosha County School and Community Services Available During School Shutdown

Madison – Today, State Representative Samantha Kerkman (R-Salem) shared information on the continuation of a senior meal program, as well as how Kenosha County schools are addressing instructional needs and school meal programs during the statewide school shutdown. Governor Evers announced today that schools will remain closed for the duration of the public health emergency.

“It is important for my constituents in the 61st Assembly District to have accurate information about what our schools are doing during this unprecedented statewide school shutdown to ensure that our children continue to receive a high quality education. In addition, families in need should be aware of how their school-aged children may continue to receive meals through the free and reduced price school lunch program,” said Rep. Kerkman.

“I am also pleased to note that the Meals on Wheels program in Kenosha County will continue to deliver meals to senior citizens between 11:00AM – 1:00PM. If Kenosha County residents have questions, please call 262-658-0237 if you live east of Interstate 94 or 262-358-5779 if you live west of Interstate 94. Of course, this information is subject to change,” continued Rep. Kerkman.

“Also, I would like to make my constituents aware that Governor Tony Evers’ office recently created a statewide website that will aggregate information and resources throughout state government with respect to the COVID-19 outbreak.
