Dear Senator Cowles and Representative Kerkman,

We, the undersigned, write today to request that you schedule a public hearing at which the Joint Legislative Audit Committee may consider directing the Legislative Audit Bureau (LAB) to conduct an audit of the Department of Corrections.

There is no doubt the department is experiencing significant problems related to staff shortages and forced overtime. Current inmate populations are 130 percent of capacity which, coupled with the staffing issues, creates a very dangerous situation. Some of us have been contacted by Corrections staff who fear retaliation from senior officials for reporting their concerns to legislators. All of this contributes to an exodus of staff in both the institutions and the agency.

Treatment of inmates has dominated the news with reports about the horrific treatment of juveniles under the custody of the Corrections at the facility in Lincoln Hills. The Federal Bureau of Investigation has reportedly taken over leadership of an investigation at Lincoln Hills. Counties like Milwaukee and Racine are removing juveniles from Lincoln Hills and this puts the entire facility existence in question.

Secretary Wall's resignation leaves many questions unanswered. Some cautiously welcomed the appointment of the new Secretary, Jon Litscher, as he has experience leading the department under then Governor Thompson. However, much has changed since Secretary Litscher's last time at the helm and an audit of Corrections could help inform the new Secretary.

An audit that would include any, if not all, of the following important issues would provide accurate, independent information from the LAB that would enable us to make evidence-based decisions about what changes are needed within Corrections:

- security and staffing,
- training of staff,
- overtime policies,
- turnover, assaults on staff in adult correctional facilities and the overall safety of staff,
- safety and care of juvenile inmates,
- human resources policies and practices.

This month both the Senate and Assembly passed Senate Joint Resolution 90, which recognized the quality, professional, nonpartisan work conduced the LAB for the past 50 years. We simply must apply the expertise of the Bureau to assess the complicated issues that have occurred within Corrections and, most importantly, help the new Secretary, the administration and the Legislature determine how best to chart a path forward to improve management of this department. The recommendations from the respected LB would provide an independent assessment that would provide valuable to the new secretary.

While we urge you to approve an audit of these corrections issues, we are already encouraging those with information about specific concerns at Corrections to contact the LAB Hotline at 1-877-FRAUD-17. As you know, the Bureau is required by law to protect the identity of the caller and will investigate the tips it receives.


