Representative Beth Meyers to Serve on the Joint Finance Committee

MADISON - Today, Assembly Democratic Leader-Elect Greta Neubauer (D-Racine) announced Representative Beth Meyers (D-Bayfield) will be appointed to serve on the Legislature's powerful Joint Committee on Finance (JFC) for the remainder of the legislative session. Representative Neubauer released the following statement:
