Republicans Call for Special Election for Secretary of State

Madison, WI – Rep. Karen Hurd (R – Fall Creek) along with her fellow legislative Republicans called for a special election for the recently vacated office of Secretary of State. Legislative Republicans brought forward a joint resolution (SJR 21) that calls on Governor Evers to hold a special election for the statewide office. The resolution passed both the Assembly and Senate on a partisan vote, with all Democrats voting against the election. “The people’s voice must be heard in the form of a statewide election to best reflect the will of the people. With 45 months remaining in the term, we hereby call on Governor Evers to hold a statewide election for Secretary of State.”
