Assembly Passes 2nd Amendment Protection Legislation

Madison, WI – Today during a floor session at the Capitol, the State Assembly passed <u>legislation</u> adding 2nd Amendment protections for firearm owners in the state, and also passed <u>legislation</u> that would terminate Wisconsin's participation in certain federal supplemental unemployment insurance (UI) programs.

"I was happy to sign on as a cosponsor of Rep. Pronschinske's bill and I'm glad we got it passed today. Democrats in Washington D.C. and Madison have made it crystal clear that they're interested in infringing on our Second Amendment rights, and anything we can do to strengthen protections for the citizens of our state is a worthwhile effort," VanderMeer said.

VanderMeer also cosponsored and supported Assembly Bill 336, which would terminate Wisconsin's participation in certain federal supplemental unemployment insurance (UI) programs, and addressed current economic and workforce conditions in the state in a <u>recent public statement</u> regarding Governor Evers' latest request for another Special Session of the Legislature.
