## **Statement on Governor Signing State Budget**

**Madison, WI** – Today, with the announcement of a number of [partial vetoes](#) to the Legislature’s budget bill, Governor Evers signed the 2021-2023 State Budget into law. [Assembly Bill 68](#) is now [2021 Wisconsin Act 58](#). Representative Nancy VanderMeer (R-Tomah), released the following statement:

“Earlier this year, Governor Evers proposed another ridiculous financial plan for our state that would have raised taxes on Wisconsinites by over \$1 billion and increased spending by over 10%. The Legislature’s budget is a responsible spending plan that makes priority investments for residents of the 70<sup>th</sup> Assembly District while not raising taxes and delivering a once in a generation type of tax cut. I was happy to support this session’s budget and I’m glad it was signed into law today. Any effort by the governor and his allies to try and take credit for tax cuts is truly comical.”

Assembly Bill 68 passed both houses of the Legislature last week with historic bipartisan support. The bill received 64 votes in the State Assembly and 23 votes in the State Senate; the most votes for a state budget in a generation.
