Rep. Shankland Announces 2015-2016 Committee Assignments

MADISON – Today, Representative Katrina Shankland (D-Stevens Point) announced that she will serve on seven legislative committees during the 2015-2016 legislative session, including serving as the ranking Democrat on the Assembly Committee on Workforce Development.
