Democratic Legislators to Host Budget Hearing in Wausau on Saturday

MADISON – Democratic lawmakers will host a listening session on the state budget at the Marathon County Public Library this Saturday, April 29th. Rep. Katrina Shankland (D-Stevens Point), Sen. LaTonya Johnson (D-Milwaukee), Rep. Amanda Stuck (D-Appleton) and Sen. Janis Ringhand (D-Evansville) invite Central Wisconsin residents to participate in public testimony on the state budget, which will be debated before the full legislature later this spring.

“The state budget impacts everyone in our state greatly. That’s why we’re traveling all over the state to listen to the people,” said Rep. Shankland, a member of the Joint Finance Committee. “We’ve heard overwhelmingly from people who strongly support our public schools, universities, clean air and water, and investing in our infrastructure. I’m looking forward to joining my legislative colleagues for our listening session on Saturday and encourage members of the public to make their voices heard.”
