## **Rep. Katrina Shankland Celebrates Inauguration & Looks Forward to the 2023-24 Legislative Session**

MADISON- Today, at the Wisconsin State Capitol, Katrina Shankland (D-Stevens Point) was officially sworn in and began her sixth term as the State Representative for Wisconsin's 71<sup>st</sup> Assembly District.

For the 2023-24 legislative session, Rep. Shankland will serve as the ranking member on the Assembly Committee on the Environment and the Assembly Committee on Workforce Development.
